This is for information of all concerned that the Part-I (Annual Mode) Examinations of PG Academic Programmes offered under the Directorate of Distance Education of the University will be conducted after 15<sup>th</sup> February 2021 in the blended mode (offline and online) as per resolutions adopted by the Task Force in its emergency meeting held on 07.01.2021 on the basis of the UGC Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar in view of COVID-19 Pandemic, [vide D.O. NO. F1-1/2020 (Secy), dated 29th April, 2020] and UGC Revised Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar for the Universities in view of COVID-19 Pandemic [vide D.O. NO. F1-1/2020 (Secy), dated 6th July, 2020, regarding conduction of M.A. Part-I examinations under Directorate of Distance Education. University shall strictly abide by the Guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC) regarding modalities of examinations for Part-I (Annual Mode) for PG Academic Programmes and spirit in the best interest of students maintaining the sanctity of examination.

Detail Modalities of Examinations for M.A. Part-I of PG Academic Programmes are mentioned below:

Students who have appeared in the MA Part I Examinations 2019, that took place on 29/02/2020, 07/03/2020 and 14/03/2020 will now take their theoretical examinations in the Blended Online-Open Book Examinations after 15<sup>th</sup> February 2021 onwards. Practical examinations will also be held from the same date. **Subject-wise specific dates of the said examinations will be notified subsequently**.

## General Instruction for the students who will be appearing blended mode (offline con line) for Part-I Examination 2019 (Session 2018-19, 2017-18, and prior to 2017-18)

- 1. Directorate will announce the detailed schedule of Examination in due course of time. Students are requested to visit the University website: <a href="www.rbudde.in">www.rbudde.in</a> regularly.
- 2. Students who will be appearing for blended mode (offline and online) for M.A. Part-I Examination 2019, are required to register in the student Portal available in the website of the DDE, RBU (www.rbudde.in). The date for registering in the said portal will be announced in subsequent notification.
- 3. In case a student of M.A. Part-I in unable to appear in the blended mode (offline and online) for M.A. Part-I Examination 2019 conducted by the University for whatsoever the reason, he/she will be given opportunity to appear in examinations for such course(s), which shall be conducted in the future by the university as and when feasible. This provision shall be applicable only for the said examination as a one-time measure.
- 4. Candidates ('Persons with Benchmark Disabilities'), 'who want to write Examination with Scribe may apply (as per Format attached) to the Joint Registrar (Exam) using University designated portal at the time of online Examination Form fill up process with all necessary document of the candidate and the Scribe.
- 5. No need to submit examination form for the students, for those who will be appearing Part-I Examination 2019 (Session 2018-19, 2017-18 Prior to 2017-18)
